## 1. The Sabbath and the Old Testament

- A. God exemplified keeping the Sabbath (Genesis 2:2-3)
- B. God commanded Israel to keep the Sabbath (Exodus 20:8-11)
  - Three purposes in keeping the Sabbath:
  - To rest in the God of creation (Exodus 20:11)
  - To <u>remember</u> the God of <u>redemption</u> (*Deuteronomy 5:15*)
  - To reflect on the God of sanctification (Exodus 31:12-13)

## 2. The Sabbath and the New Testament

- A. Jesus and the Sabbath
- B. Believers and the Sabbath
  - The <u>command</u> to keep the Sabbath <u>is not repeated</u> (Colossians 2:16-17)
  - The celebration on Sunday is obvious
  - The <u>controversy</u> for today (*Romans 14*)

Believers are to be led by a clear conscience, confirmation of the Holy Spirit, & faith
