Exodus 20:13

1. What this command means:

God forbids the <u>unjust taking</u> of a human life. This includes homicide, suicide, and abortion.

2. What this command does not teach:

This command:

- A. Is not against killing animals
- B. Does not negate the reality of war (Exodus 17:15+)
- C. Does not negate protecting yourself (Exodus 22:2)
- D. Takes accidents into consideration (Numbers 35:9-25)
- E. Is not against capital punishment

Three facts about capital punishment:

- o It was instituted before the Law (Genesis 9:6-7)
- o It was confirmed as part of the Law (Exodus 21:12)
- o It is affirmed in the New Testament (Romans 12:17-13:7)

3. What this command does teach:

Life is precious and:

- A. Murder is not an option (Exodus 20:13)
- B. Anger needs to be dealt with (Matthew 5:21-22)
- C. Encouragement needs to be shared (Proverbs 18:21)
- D. Love needs to be shown (1 John3:11-15)
