A NEW YEAR'S REVOLUTION

Matthew 13:1-9

The greatest need in the Church culture today is not a new year's resolution but a New Revolution.

The parable of the sower Jesus tells illustrates three kinds of Christians.

I. The <u>Cultural</u> Christian

And as he sowed, some seed fell by the wayside; and the birds came and devoured them. (Matthew 13:4)

II. The Congregational Christian

Some fell on stony places, where they did not have much earth; and they immediately sprang up because they had no depth of earth. ⁶ But when the sun was up they were scorched, and because they had no root they withered away. ⁷ And some fell among thorns, and the thorns sprang up and choked them. (Mathew 13:5-7)

III. The Convictional Christian

But others fell on good ground and yielded a crop: some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty (Matthew 13:8)
