#### 1. The call to God's prophet

- A. Malachi <u>received</u> God's Word
- B. Malachi spoke God's Word

### 2. The context of God's people

- A. They lost <u>focus</u> of who God is!
  - God is a Father 1:6
  - God is a Master 1:6
  - God is a great King 1:14
  - God is the Lord of Armies 1:6, 14
    - 3 key passages on the Lord of Armies (Hosts):
    - Seraphim crying out in worship Isaiah 6:3
    - Hannah in prayer in 1 Samuel 1:11
    - David fighting Goliath 1 Samuel 17:45

# B. They lived in spiritual <u>apathy</u>

Their sarcastic questions: "In what way have you loved us?" 1:2 "In what way have we despised Your name?" 1:6 "In what way have we defiled You?" 1:7 "In what way have we wearied Him?" 2:17 "In what way shall we return?" 3:7 "In what way have we robbed You?" 3:8 "What have we spoken against You?" 3:13

# 3. The challenge of God's Word

- A. God sees when we apathetically <u>go through the motions</u> Look in: <u>Examine your heart</u> Look up: <u>Honor God</u> 1:6, 11
- B. God knows when we would rather <u>argue than repent</u>
  Look in: <u>Quit justifying your sin</u>
  Look up: <u>Return to God</u> 3:7
- C. God loves when we <u>don't even deserve it</u> Look in: <u>Receive God's love</u> 1:2 Look up: <u>Trust God</u> 3:16-17
