FOUR PHASES OF DYNAMIC CHRISTIAN LIVING

Colossians 2:6a (CSB)

It is the will of God that every believer experience a dynamic Christian life. However, the sad truth is that many believers only occasionally experience the "inexpressible and glorious joy" (I Peter 1:1-8) that God intends for them. They know little or nothing of the victorious Christian life that the Apostle Paul so often spoke of in his letters to individuals and/or churches of the 1st century.

That's because they have never really grasped the simple (yet profound) truth of *how* to live the Christian life. Generally speaking, they know *what* the Christian life ought to look like. The problem is: They have never understood how to achieve it.

Today we want to examine the issue of *how* to live such a life – and we will do that by examining the phases that believers go through on their way toward spiritual maturity.

- 1. This is easy
- 2. This is difficult
- 3. This is impossible
- 4. This is Christ

Summation: One lives the Christian life in exactly the same way one comes into the Christian life (i.e., by simply trusting Jesus).
