John 19:1-24

(Read John 19:12-19)

1. Jesus predicted the cross

- John 3:14-15 “The Son of Man must be lifted up”
- John 8:28 “When you lift up the Son of Man...”
- John 12:30-33 “If I am lifted up from the earth, I will draw all people to myself...”

2. Jesus faced the cross

Jesus was:

- Betrayed by Judas (John 18:1-3)
- Empowered by God (18:4-8)
- Alone as His disciples fled (18:8-9, John 16:31-32)
- Despised by Jewish leaders (18:22, 31, 19:6-7, 12, 15)
- Sentenced by Pilate (19:16)
- Crucified by the Romans (19:16-24)

3. Jesus submitted to the cross

Jesus laid down His life:

- Willingly (John 10:11,15, 17,18; 15:13)
- Sacrificially (10:15)
- To provide salvation (10:27-28)

Application:

- 2. Recognize your value in Christ**
